The Edith Bishel Center is a 501© 3 corporation that is a premier provider of individualized assistance through programs, trainings, and social opportunities, that enrich the individual quality of life of the blind and visually impaired in Eastern Washington and Northeastern Oregon.

What is the Twilight Saga: Breaking Dawn (Part 1) Premiere Party Fundraiser?

The Breaking Dawn (Part 1 and Part 2) Premiere Party is a **fundraiser** event based off the characters of the Twilight books. We offer a large party venue, including food, Twilight based activities and crafts, vendors, a silent and live auctions, a theatrical performance, fashion show, local Twilight Look-a-Likes prior to the midnight movie premiere, and tickets to a private midnight premiere showing of Breaking Dawn (Part 1) on November 17, 2011. The event held at the TRAC in Pasco is almost solely funded by donations of other local community sponsors and the money raised goes to assist in providing services to the blind and visually impaired in our community and the surrounding areas. This will be the third year the center has offered a Twilight Saga Movie Premiere party!

How do I audition for a Look-a-Like position?

The first thing to understand is that we are looking for two things in our look-a-likes. First, a resemblance, minor or major, to one of the characters in the Twilight Saga movies, and second and most important, a great personality in which to interact with the party attendees in character, take photos, and work in collaboration with the other cast and crew to put on a wonderful event.

If you are up to the challenge, you may fill out the attached application and you must attend a cold read audition.

Auditionees will be expected to:

- 1) Come in an appropriately representative costume—we want to see your best effort at looking like the character you are auditioning for. If you have more than one character you are interested in—come dressed as the primary character you are auditioning for and perhaps provide photos of you as the other characters for our consideration during casting. Please represent the costuming from the Eclipse movie/book.
- 2) You will be asked to cold read a few pages from our script with other actors who are auditioning and or have previously participated. This is to see what kind of acting ability you have, as the look-a-likes perform 8 theatrical productions and participate as models in a Twilight Fashion show.

If cast, what will be expected of me?

You will be expected to:

- 1) Make a commitment to the Edith Bishel Center cast and crew for rehearsals of the theatrical production and fashion show beginning in August through the night of the event on November 17, 2011. **Rehearsal schedules are to be determined at a later date.**
- 2) Participate in the promotional events that may be scheduled between May and November 2011. This will include a couple of mandatory promotional photo shoots for posters and other materials.
- 3) Provide your own look-a-like costume(s) for the event. There is no budget for costuming of the look-a-likes. Make-up and hair styling are done for the night of the event only by volunteers. For any
